About Aleta:

Over the last twenty-one years Aleta has trained and titled her own dogs in Obedience, Flyball, Dock Diving, Agility, Herding, Field, and Barn Hunt, to include Rottweilers, Labs, Border Collies, and a Papillon. She is trained in Search/Rescue and has conducted in-home dog behavior consultations/training for eight years to include a variety of breeds. Aleta was first introduced to Barn Hunt in 2013, became certified as a Barn Hunt Judge in April 2015. She currently runs the #1 Papillon in Barn Hunt w/ a RATCHX3, three BC's w/ RATCHX6, RATCHX4 and RATCHX3 titles. Her BC's, Buzz and Ripp ranked high in the 2015 & 2016 BH Nationals. Aleta has enjoyed teaching others to hunt rats with their own dogs of various breeds over the last two years. She has directed her studies the last nine years to dog behavior, successfully completing a twenty-one day advanced dog training and behavior course. Course content included behavior counseling, behavior modification programs, behavior problems, house-training, separation problems, fears and phobias, dog/dog aggression, and dog/human aggression. Practical training included exercises and training concepts, obedience competition training and handling, tracking, detection, and hearing dog work.
