NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Entry fees: \$26.00 (includes AKC recording* and service fee) for the first entry of a dog in each agility Trial, \$21.00 for the 2nd, 3rd, 4th entry of the same dog in the same Trial, \$21.00 for the third entry of the same dog in the same trial.

* **Chapter 1, Section 27. Recording Fees.** At every licensed or member club trial, a recording fee of \$3.50 shall be required for the first entry of each dog, and \$3.00 for each additional entry of the same dog. (Each day is a separate trial.) Non-regular agility classes do not require a recording fee. When the recording fee is calculated, it does not include withdrawals.

Entries without fees will not be accepted. Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as practical. Should such acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Trial Secretary.

Entries not on official AKC entry forms or photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not acceptable.
Express entries: Please use "release signature" or the entry will be delayed.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Entry fees shall not be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.
Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event, it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, **no refund** of entry fee will be made.

REFUNDS

Bitches in season will not be admitted to the trial. Any exhibitor with an entered bitch in season, on the trial date, will be refunded the entry fee, less \$3.00 per run (each day), upon written certification from a veterinarian. Notification must be in the hands of the trial secretary no later than the start time on the date of the trial.

Errors on entry blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms. No entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

The Trial Secretary will do her best to estimate the start time of each class.

Dogs may arrive at any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. **All dogs present** must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.

Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents are responsible for the presence of their dogs in judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. No dog may be permanently removed from the show before it is judged except by consent of the Trial Secretary upon a veterinarian's recommendation of removal.

RIBBONS AND AWARDS

First Prize.....	Blue Rosette
Second Prize.....	Red Rosette
Third Prize.....	Yellow Rosette
Fourth Prize.....	White Rosette
Qualifying Score.....	Dark green flat Ribbon

MACH/PACH/PAX Rosettes and a MACH/PACH/ PAX Bar will be given to exhibitors earning a MACH / PACH or PAX title at this trial. All ribbons and prizes must be claimed the day of the Trial: none will be mailed.

OBSTACLES

All obstacles and equipment used at this trial meet the requirements for agility trials.

Saturday Classes

LOW to HIGH (4, 8, 12, 16, 20, 24, 24C)

Fast – T2B, All STD classes (EX/MAS, OPEN, NOV)

Followed by All JWW classes (EX/MAS, OPEN, NOV)

Sunday Classes

LOW to HIGH (4, 8, 12, 16, 20, 24, 24C)

All JWW classes (EX/MAS, OPEN, NOV) T2B, All Standard classes (EX/MAS, OPEN, NOV)

Preferred Classes will run with the regular classes at the height divisions

Jump Height Card Process – The Judge is a VMO. All dogs without a temporary or permanent Height Card need to be measured. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

You may bring your lunch and a drink and eat in the crating area or outside or in your vehicle.

During this time there will be NO EATING on the Agility Side of the Building. You may have a covered drink.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This Trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

MOVE-UPS

Pretrial move-ups may be submitted (email preferred) by Apr 4, 2023 at 6pm. Please use the name and date of the trial in the subject. Include your dog's call name and the move-up class... You may move-up your dog on the first day of the trial for any following days.

Day to day move-ups are accepted as long as you request the move-up within 30 minutes of the end of the last class. It is appreciated if the move-up is made as soon as possible.

ENTRY INFORMATION

All entries must be submitted on official AKC entry forms. One dog per entry form.

Entries will not be accepted without signature, back of entry form with agreement, and fees, nor will email, telephone or FAX entries

Owners are responsible for ensuring that entry forms are completed in **FULL. ***PLEASE PRINT EMAIL ADDRESS CLEARLY!!!**

Limit 10 entries per envelope.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. A \$35.00 service fee will be added for all returned checks.

Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address.

AKC does NOT require Breeder, Sire or Dam Information on the entry form.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

1. Site opens daily at 8:00AM
2. Crates may be left overnight; however, MDTC will NOT be responsible for any loss of damaged items at the show site.
3. Bottles Water will be available for all exhibitors.
4. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs.

Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers with Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A **separate entry form** must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Clubs holding agility trials will be required to offer Fix and Go On for all classes. Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

Entering for Exhibition Only (FEO)

MDTC will NOT be offering FEO at these trials.

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.

Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line.

Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.

Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.

The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).

Toys are allowed in the ring

- o Toys must be non-audible
- o Toys may not leave the handler's hand
- o Toys that roll freely cannot be used

Food/treats are not allowed in the ring

FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.

A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

The CLUB WILL BE FOLLOWING the COVID-19 Guidelines provided by the Governor of VA.

At this time there are no mask requirements. However, if you wish to wear one that is your choice. There will be no chairs setup in the trial side (bldg. 15). There are a couple of special needs folks who will be sitting.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners** SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

I CERTIFY that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above.
